

Registering for Sunday Liturgy—Confession—Safety Guidelines and More

1. Our normal daily services have resumed, and **there is no registration for these**. This includes the daily vespers services, and Saturday morning Orthros and Liturgy. The only difference will be that Saturday Orthros/Liturgy (at least) will be in the church temple instead of the chapel. All are invited. The same limit of 100 applies. **These daily services will not be live-streamed.**
2. We have implemented a St. Andrew parishioner registration process for Sunday morning services. We are currently permitted to have up to 100 people inside the temple for services. Parishioners must register ALL persons attending the services online at: <https://www.saintandrewphase3.net/services>. Those who wish to come on Sunday but are not successful in registering can come to Divine Liturgy Saturday morning – 7:30am Orthros, 8am Divine Liturgy.
3. We are working to organize the registration process to ensure that an opportunity to attend Divine Liturgy in the temple on Sunday is evenly distributed. For example, expect that for every one Sunday you are inside, this will be followed by the next outside. **Sunday morning services will continue - for the time being - to be live streamed for those parishioners who remain at home.**

We have been blessed by our Metropolitan to allow parishioners - who were not able to be in the church - to nonetheless come to Church on Sunday morning for the services and to pray them outside, and then to come to the narthex at the time of Holy Communion in the Divine Liturgy. One of the clergy will serve communion to those parishioners who were praying outside the church.

4. **Confession times have resumed as usual:** Saturday evening at Great Vespers and following, Sunday morning during Orthros (9-10am), after daily services, and by appointment. For those who need confession but are not allowed in the temple you may come to the confessional using the north/east door, and then return the same way immediately after confession.

Unique Safety Protocols for Reopening

- **If you are sick, stay home.** If you or anyone in your household is ill, we ask that you wait to attend services until you're 100% symptom free.
- **Masks are encouraged.** Most of our parishioners will be wearing masks during the services as an act of love towards others. You are encouraged to do the same.
- **High Risk & Seniors.** We will be extra careful when our seniors and immune-compromised parishioners return. Social distancing inside the temple will be adhered to.
- **Temperature Checks.** A small temperature check station will be set up outside the temple. All parishioners should stop by and have their temperature checked. 100.4 or below is our goal. Handwashing stations and sanitizer are also available for use prior to entering. We have a small supply of masks if you forget yours.
- **Physical Distancing.** You will also find blue markings on the floor to guide in social distancing.
- **Communion Line.** Children may line up first for Holy Communion on the blue markings on the floor. Adults should remain in their spot until dismissed by an usher.
- **Registration.** Do not be discouraged if you see registration has been filled. We will ensure that there is a rotation of parishioners attending Sunday morning Liturgy. In that regard, please be respectful of your brothers and sisters. Do not register for every Sunday service to allow others to attend in the temple.
